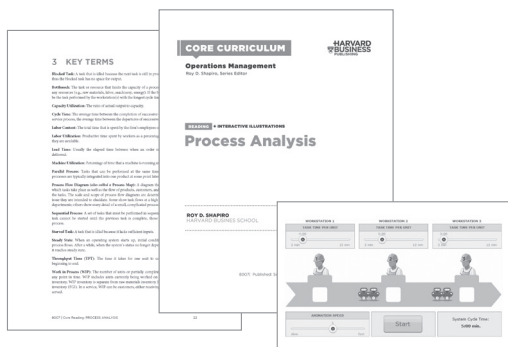


Core Curriculum in Operations Management
